USGA Rules Govern All Play Except Where Modified By Local Rules

Play from an Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA) is strictly prohibited. Rock walls, fences, red stakes with green tops and/or red marking paint with appropriate signage will define an ESA. A player is not allowed to enter an ESA at any time. If a player's ball is known or virtually certain to be in an ESA, a player has three options, each for one penalty stroke: (1) stroke-and-distance relief (2) back-on-the-line relief; or (3) lateral relief.

If a player's swing or stance is impeded by an ESA wall, stake or fence, a player may take relief—without penalty—within one club-length, but no closer to the hole, of the point at which there is no interference to the player's stance or intended area of their swing.

Historical trails on holes #16 and #18 are marked as Ground Under Repair. Players must take GUR relief with no penalty. Play from inside the marked trail area is prohibited.

Please Help with The Following

- Maintain a four-hour pace of play (play "ready golf")
- Repair ball marks
- Fill divots with sand from bottles on cart
- Please follow cart directional signage
- Enter and exit grass areas from the cart paths only
- After raking a bunker, place the rake outside of the bunker
